

As Tarrant County's population continues to grow, we see more patients needing health and mental health services. This letter shares a few updates on North Texas Area Community Health Centers (NTACHC) and how we are working to serve the growing needs of our community.



NTACHC Treated 12,000 Patients in 2024

Of NTACHC's 12,000 plus patients, 69.5% are female and include children and youth under 18. NTACHC is the only Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) in Tarrant County, and we provide care to everyone in our community–no matter your background or circumstances. We offer a range of payment options to help make care affordable and accessible for you.

Living Your Best Life Receives Accolades

NTACHC started our Living Your Best Life (LYBL) for many people facing diabetes and hypertension. We received funding to implement remote patient monitoring (RPM) into a second arm of our Living

patients). Nearly 80% of the patients enrolled in RPM are now in good control. We currently have 339 patients enrolled, and over 500 patients have been a part of this program in total since we began. To showcase our great work, NTACHC was featured in the NHCI Data Integration Roadmap shared nationally by HRSA to help other health centers across the country implement RPM and improve health outcomes.

New Arlington Location

In summer 2024, we moved the Arlington Health Center to a new location to better serve our neighbors in the Vandergriff Building, 1001 N. Waldrop Dr., Suite #708 Arlington, TX 76012. Thanks to Texas Health Resources allowing us space at a slightly reduced rent.

Joyful Beginnings: A Maternal Health and Wellness Program

Established in 2023, NTACHC's Joyful Beginnings-Maternal Health and Wellness Program was created to help reduce maternal and infant mortality for all pregnant women in the high risk or low economic status. The number of patients has more than doubled. We have pregnant patients and see them and their babies through their first 12 months. In 2024, NTACHC added Rocki's closet, modeled after Dr. Virginia Caine's B.A.B.E.S. program, to provide practical items such as diapers, clothing, cribs, car seats and more.
